1 April 2023

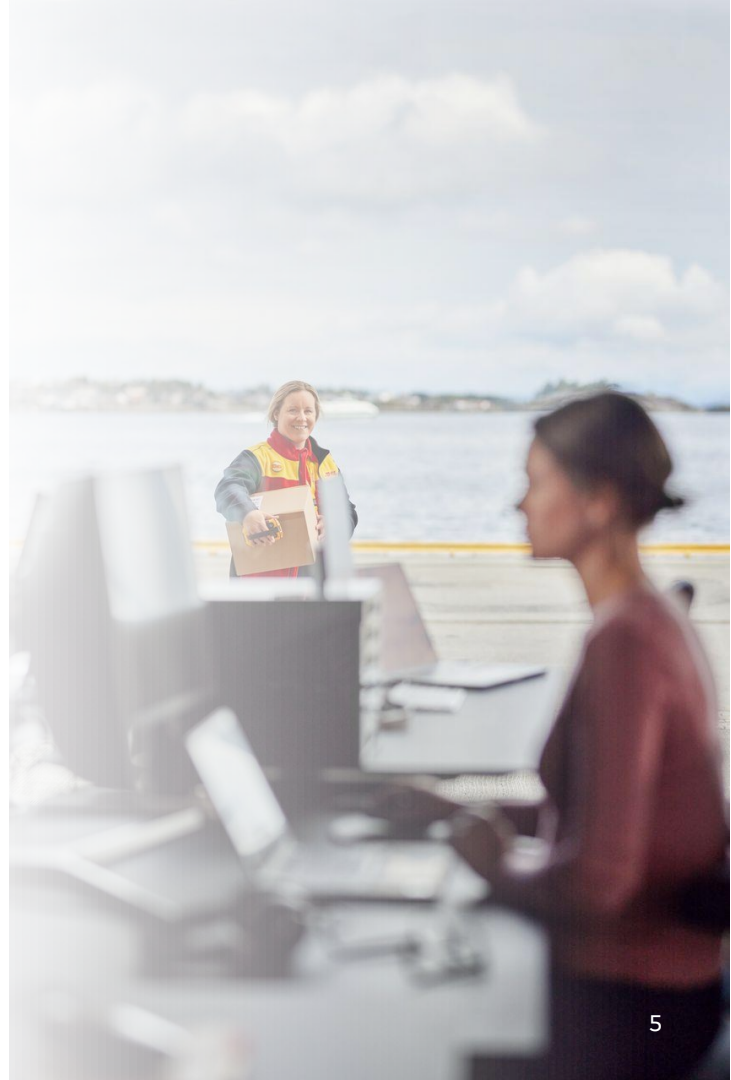
WHAT CHANGES IS CDS BRINGING?



It's basically a change in IT system for making UK customs declarations:
From CHIEF to CDS



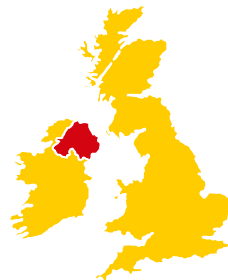
We'll also need to enter additional data:
Including Incoterms and place



HOW ARE WE PREPARING?



We have upgraded our systems and are running CHIEF and CDS concurrently



We've been using CDS for shipments between the UK and Northern Ireland, and NI and the rest of the world, for more than 18 months



Our teams across the UK are fully trained on CDS and ready for the switchover on 1 October!

If you are a UK importer and run your own Deferment Account and we handle your customs:

Register for CDS using your HMRC Government Gateway account

This gives you access to your CDS Financial dashboard



Set up a new Direct Debit for your Duty Deferment Account



Authorise DHL Global Forwarding to use your Duty Deferment Account in CDS
