Subject Customer Advisory: US East and Gulf Coast Port Labor Dispute

Dear Customer,

We are continuing to closely monitor the market situation in the **United States** and would like to provide you with an update regarding US East and Gulf Coast ports.

On January 8th an agreement was reached by the ILA and USMX to achieve a new 6-year contract, averting a potential East and Gulf Coast work stoppage on January 16th. The ILA and USMX will continue to operate under the existing contract pending a ratification vote and no service interruptions are expected.

To ensure full visibility of your shipments during this period, we encourage you to utilize **myDHLi**, our digital platform, that offers real-time cargo tracking and efficient booking management.
