

# DHL Freight: Road Freight Groupage Departures to and from Finland during the Holiday Season 2024 / 2025

Holidays around Christmas and the New Year cause changes to DHL Freight groupage schedules in both import and export. Normal schedules and lead times do not apply; please see information below. Please also note that due to Finnish Independence Day on Fri December 6, shipment pick-ups need to take place on Thu December 5 at the latest.

## Continental Europe, UK and Ireland

#### **Export and import**

- Last scheduled departures with delivery before Christmas: Fri December 13
- First scheduled departures in 2025 as of week 2

## Baltics: Estonia, Latvia, Lithuania

#### **Export and import**

- During week 51, regular scheduled departures
- During week 52, no departures (Mon / Fri December 23 and 27 cancelled)
- Week 1: Scheduled departures except on Wed January 1, 2025
- Week 2: Scheduled departures except on Mon January 6

#### Central Eastern Europe, Balkan and Turkey

#### Poland, Czech Republic, Slovakia, Hungary - export and import

- Last scheduled departures with delivery before Christmas: Fri December 13
- First scheduled departures in 2025 as of week 2

#### Other countries – export and import

- Last scheduled departures on Fri December 13; deliveries as of week 2/2025
- First scheduled departures in 2025 as of week 2

## Scandinavia: Sweden, Norway, Denmark

Please note that transport capacity may be limited during weeks 51/2024 - 1/2025 in both export and import.

## Norway and Denmark - export and import

- Last scheduled departures with delivery before Christmas: Fri December 13
- Shipments collected during December 16-23: delivery after Christmas

## Sweden – export and import

- Last scheduled departures with delivery before Christmas: Wed December 18
- Shipments collected during December 19-23: delivery after Christmas
